The 2026 Winter Scientific Seminar will be held Thursday, January 15 through Sunday, January 18, at The Grandover Resort in Greensboro, North Carolina.

General sessions will begin at 8:00 am on Thursday, January 15 and the meeting will adjourn by 1:00 pm on Sunday, January 18. We anticipate offering 25 hours of continuing medical education.

The Seminar Committee has already begun filling the schedule! On Thursday, residents from Wake Forest Baptist and Cape Fear Valley Residency Programs will speak. Friday afternoon will include lectures on Human Trafficking, Controlled Substance Prescribing, and Risk Management. A tentative schedule will be available shortly.

The Grandover Resort is located at 1000 Club Road, Greensboro NC 27407. Make sleeping room reservations by calling 336-294-1800. Let Reservations know that you are with the NC Foot & Ankle Society to receive the group rate of \$239.00 (single or double), plus state and local taxes, and resort service fees. Premium King and Parlor Suite rooms are available for additional fees. The deadline to register at the group rate is December 16, 2025 OR when the block sells out. After that date, the rate will increase, and staff will not be able to assist with reservations.

Attendees will be provided with name badges with bar codes. Bar codes must be scanned at the beginning of every morning and every afternoon general session. Failure to follow the scanning schedule may result in loss of hours. In addition, attendees will be provided with a sign-in card for the statutorily-required opioid training. The card must be returned immediately following training. Failure to attend the entirety of the lecture or to sign and return the card will result in loss of continuing education.
